

Up and coming actors nominated for Stockholm Rising Star Award

The Stockholm Rising Star Award is granted an actor or actress who is showing signs of becoming tomorrow's next big star. The idea is to give the actor an early career lift and to provide them with a vast movie industry network at the Stockholm International Film Festival.

Last year the award went to Aliette Opheim, who had her breakthrough with *Det vita folket* (2015).

The jury reviews all Swedish films from November to November to find the best up and coming actors.
